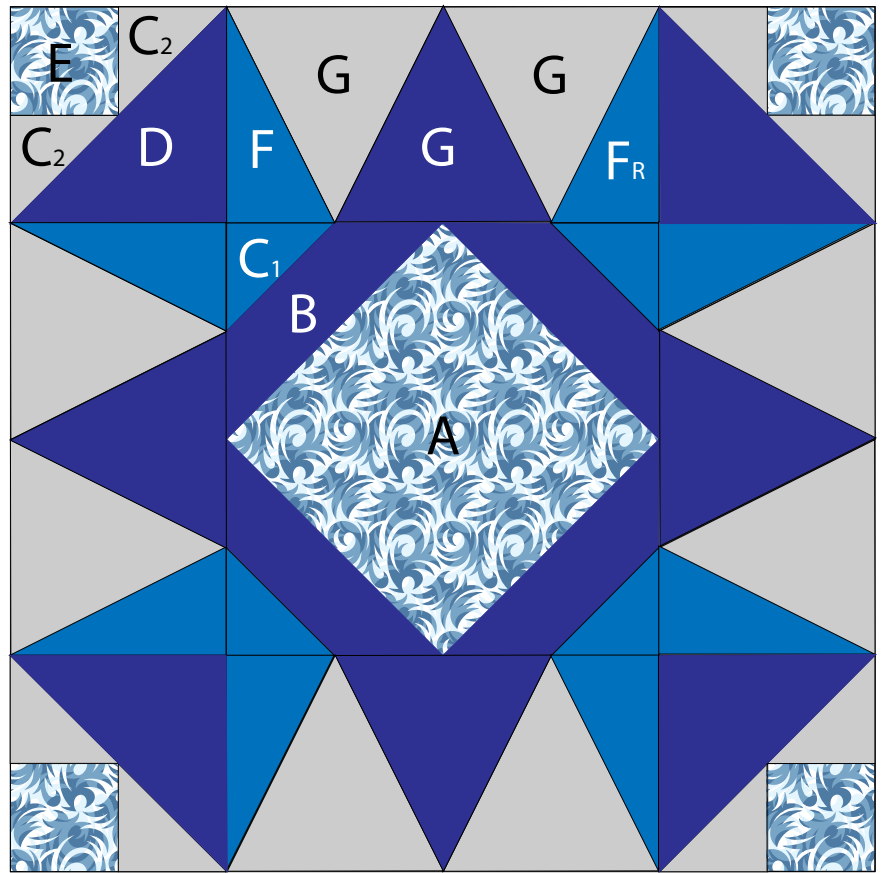


Odette Quilt Block

Traditional Cutting Instructions



Unit	Cutting	Fabric	Total Yield
A	Cut 5: 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares	From Focus/Theme	5 squares
B	Cut 10: 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares divide diagonally	From Dark	20 HSTs
C1	Cut 20: 2" squares	From Medium	20 squares
C2	Cut 20: 2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " squares divide diagonally	From Light	40 HSTs
D	Cut 10: 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares divide diagonally	From Dark	20 HSTs
E	Cut 20: 2" squares	From Focus/Theme	20 squares
F	Cut 10: 2 $\frac{1}{8}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " rec.	From Medium	20, slant left
FR	Cut 10: 2 $\frac{1}{8}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " rec.	From Medium	20, slant right
G	Cut 40: from template*	From Light	40, Bias triangles
G	Cut 20: from template*	From Dark	20, Bias triangles

* by using two layers of fabric, either right or wrong sides together, a diagonal cut through the 3 $\frac{1}{8}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle will yield two Fs and and two FRs.
