



Pocket Tissue Cover

Materials

Scrap fabrics of your choice. Pieces need to be at least 4" x 6"

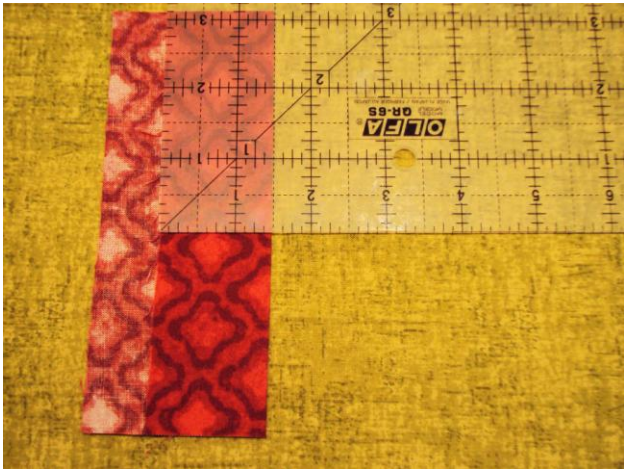
Thread to match

Tissue packet. Ours measures 4 ¼" x 2 ¼"

1. Cut Fabric:

Cut three (3) rectangles measuring 3 ¾" x 5 ¾" each

2. Sewing Top Opening:



Fold one long edge of a rectangle under 1 ½", and press. Repeat with a second rectangle.

Turn under ¼" of pressed edge. Stitch. Repeat with second rectangle.



With right sides facing down, overlap folded edges of rectangles



Tack in place the overlapping edges along the outer edge using a 1/8" seam allowance.

3. Assembling Tissue Cover:



With right sides facing, center top on backing rectangle. There will be a bit of backing fabric showing. This will be trimmed away later. .



Stitch using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance around the entire outside edge. Trim excess fabric. Clip corners. Turn right side out and press.



Insert your tissue pack through the opening.
